At Sand Point, we think nature has its place – and that place is in and around our vineyards. We’ve restored the riparian habitat where our ranch meets the Mokelumne River – including the spot that gave Sand Point its name. Since then, we’ve brought nearby sloughs back into natural balance and surrounded our vineyards with 15-foot-wide swaths of native plants and trees, inviting bugs, birds and animals to make themselves at home. In return, the healthy soil and water nourishes our vines. Wild? Yes... but to us, it’s following in nature’s footsteps.

A vibrant Sauvignon Blanc with a dash of pink-grapefruit and citrus-lime notes that are softened by a hint of pineapple-guava character in both the aroma and flavor. As a fruit forward wine with balanced acidity and a smooth texture, our 2018 vintage is bright and refreshing.
